



\$1,000 REWARD

On Saturday June 26th, an adult male American Bulldog was found dead after being tied out for several days on the 1200 Block of 16th St. NE. The dog succumbed to heat exhaustion and dehydration after being left unattended for several days in the summer heat. He was seen tied out and alive as early as the Thursday prior to when it was found dead by officers on Saturday the 26th.

The Washington Humane Society desperately needs the help of the community for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this horrific act of animal cruelty. The Washington Humane Society is offering a \$1,000 reward that will be given to any person who provides such information.
